Siria Taurelli is senior expert in VET Governance and lifelong learning at the European Training Foundation.

She has led the “VET governance toolbox”, a set of concepts and related tools that the ETF applies in its work with partner countries. At the ETF, VET Governance refers to the concept of good multi-level governance. This concept applies to legislative, institutional and financing arrangements of VET systems; it encompasses participatory governance, actors’ coordinated action and shared responsibility, cooperation between public and private sectors within each governance level; and vertical coordination between national, sub-national and sectoral levels.

Siria is currently coordinating the ETF study “Public-private partnership for skills development”, which will compare types and forms of PPPs in the skills development domain, internationally and in Jordan, Kazakhstan, Serbia and Ukraine. The study started in 2018 and the results will be presented in December 2019.

She has been working on lifelong learning with focus on continuing VET, skills for enterprise development, equity and human capital development thematic areas. Project evaluation and impact assessment are also part of her expertise.

She is author and contributor to a number of ETF briefings and publications, on social partners’ engagement in VET, country progress indicators, Torino Process, VET sector in Morocco and Serbia among others.
